My Staff table has records on persons in the department and these can be edited via the "div\_staff(upd1)" task. Currently, this task is available from the "div\_staff(list1)" task. This menu structure allows any user to update the record of all other users. I want to allow the user to edit only their own record. To accomplish this, I want to let the user update their personal data from the "Menu" task (Home Page) where the user can also change their password ("mnu\_user(upd)a" task. So I added "div\_staff(upd1)" task to Navigation Buttons(1) under the "Menu" task. The selection now shows (as desired) but I get the message "Nothing has been selected yet" when clicking to update the staff record. How/where can I tell Radicore which staff record (the current user) to edit? Am I doing this correctly?
