Still struggling unfortunately. I tried a couple of different patterns but I'm not achieving the result I want. Eventually I thought that the most appropriate pattern would just be an output pattern, calling the popup as initial passthrough. This almost works perfectly except that the selection criteria is not being passed back in the \$where string. In the debugger, breaking in the \_cm\_initialise of the output task I see \$selection = NULL and \$where is the original where clause with no additional data.

I saw this with a couple of the other patterns too actually - is it pattern dependent and is there a solution?
