Yes I am activating via a navigation button from a LIST2 transaction (there are two navigation buttons - one for each report).

The list2 transaction has the parent table that does NOT contain rdcaccount\_id, and the child table DOES contain rdcaccount\_id. Thus each user sees all the data from the parent table, but only their own rows from the child table. It works fine for the administration of the data, but not for the output2 tasks.
