Well you are correct in that this is the root cause of the problem because the table cost\_group does not contain rdcaccount\_id and so this is not specified in the \$selection string.

In the original post in this thread I pointed out that I have linked two tables, only ONE of which contains rdcaccount\_id.

The functionality I have tried to create is to have a master set of items (using table cost\_group not containing rdcaccount\_id). Each account owner can then create their own scale of charges for these items (using table cost\_group\_charge containing rdcaccount\_id) and related to table cost\_group using cost\_group\_id.

The framework is handling it perfectly apart from the reporting.
