Drilling down into dict\_table\_s01 the \_cm\_getInitialDataMultiple function ultimately calls \$this->\_ddl\_showTables. Inside the MySQL, MySQLi, and PgSql versions the function grabs the dbprefix from \$GLOBALS. Loooking at the Oracle versions there is no reference to the dbprefix in the file.

Are you using the Oracle version and hence the reason things work for you and not me? I don't have oracle installed anywhere to test this out.

I know the dbprefix gets appended in dict\_table\_s01 as well in the mysql calls to \_ddl\_showTables. Hence the doubling up of dbprefix.
