The name "audit" is perfectly valid (you did create a database named "audit", didn't you?) but the leading "****" leads me to believe that your config.inc file (which was copied from config.inc.default) has the value "****" defined for \$GLOBALS['dbprefix']. You need to change all the values in config.inc to what is relevant for your installation, especially those currently filled with "****".
