My hosting company enforces the web###- db prefix so there was no way around it without a fix to core code.

On a separate installation note, this hosting company does not allow individual .htaccess files. The easiest way around the include path problem was simply to create a one line php.ini at the radcore doc root and enter the statement `include_path = "whatever/your/path/is/here"`.

On my own development environment I have a standard include path for all my system but that is in the main php.ini.

Other folks may have the same issue when using a hosted environment.
