This problem can be isolated to file php\_session.class.inc, function gc.

Starting from version 1.73 \_dml\_deleteSelection("last\_updated < DATE\_SUB(NOW(), INTERVAL \$max\_lifetime SECOND)") is used as criteria to clean up the session table during logon process. MYSQL will produce dates and time in the timezone of localhost while PHP uses UTC as default timezone. Hence, if your localhost pc runs for example an Asian timezone, your logon session will always be wiped out by the garbage collector function gc. When I change my pc timezone to UTC, it works fine. Also, if I revert function gc back to what it was in version 1.72 it works fine too, because there all time and dates are derived from PHP functions, no mixing up of SQL and PHP dates.

I suspect you can replicate this problem by setting your localhost pc timezone to UTC +5 or greater.
