rafs wrote on Fri, 10 July 2015 23:21 In my old schema I have a 'users' table which was linked to the 'created\_at', and 'updated\_at' fields of almost every table in the database.

(1) In my RADICORE implementation, will I need to rename my table fields to 'created\_date', 'revised\_date', 'created\_user', 'revised\_user', in order to work seamlessly with the RADICORE auto-insert methods?

(2) If I want to do a bulk import of my user records directly in mnu\_user table, what is the hashing algorithm used before storing, and after loading?

Thanks.

(1) Surely you mean that the 'user\_id' column is linked to the 'created\_user' and 'revised\_user' columns? You cannot link a user\_id column to columns containing dates.

Although I have a 'created\_user' and 'revised\_user' column on each table in my database I never relate them bac to the MNU\_USER table as this would be overkill.

(2) You could always turn password encryption OFF during the bulk import and import plain text passwords, then turn encryption ON again afterwards. You can do this on the 'Menu Controls' screen.
