You need to look at the code in the \_cm\_initialise() method of the parent entity in the POPUP2 task. If the \$where string contains something that identifies an entry on that table then continue, otherwise jump to a POPUP1 task to allow the user to select an entry.

This means that when calling the POPUP2 task and you already have a value for the parent entity which you want to use then this value must be included in the \$where string which is passed to the POPUP2 task.
