I changed tablenames in my database and now I have a problem with a few tables when I want to delete a record. The following error message comes up:

I can insert, read and update records in these tables but not delete them. I checked the tasks in the Menu system and if there is the correct tablename in the htm\_orga\_kontakte(del1).php file. I exported the tables to php once more. I also stepped through the code with the debugger but in the end I didn't recognize where my fault is.

What else can I do to solve this problem? Is there another place/table where I have to change the tablenames? I wonder why I can delete records in some tables and in some tables not.
