I can immediately see that you are doing some things in a questionable way.

- 1) When using RDCsingleton:getInstance('table.class.inc') you do not need to require/include the class file beforehand as this is handled automatically in the getInstance method.
- 2) The ability to access classes in another subsystem should be handled by putting the path to that other subsystem in the htaccess file. Alternatively you can use 'subsystem/table.class.inc' in the call to getInstance() as this will automatically update include\_path.
- 3) I do not understand why in the \_cm\_pre\_getData method for that table you are reading data from a different table in a different subsystem. Your LIST1 task should go directly to the child table without having to go through the parent table.
