I would advise against modifying any of the standard files in the framework as they are used by every component within the application, and you could introduce no end of problems. This would make debugging more difficult, and cause you problems whenever a new version of the framework is released

This is custom code, and the correct place for custom code is inside a custom method within the relevant database table class. If you wish to modify the WHERE clause before a SELECT, such as by adding "user\_id=\$GLOBALS['logon\_user\_id']", then you can do so in the `_cm_preGetData()` method (take a look at [http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/functions-and-variables.html#notes.\\_cm\\_pre\\_getdata](http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/functions-and-variables.html#notes._cm_pre_getdata))
