Before a new record is actually inserted a check is made to ensure that the primary key does not already exist, and the identity of the primary key is obtained from \$this->primary\_key in the .dict.inc file. If this is empty then the 'SELECT count(\*) FROM \$tablename WHERE \$where' query will fail.

When you are transferring an application from one server to another it is not necessary to re-export all the files from the data dictionary - you can simply copy across all the .class.inc and .dict.inc files from the first server.
