If you want a separate dropdown list on three different columns on the same record then you simply create three separate entries in `$this->lookup_data`. There is no such limitation as one dropdown per record. You can have as many as you like. Each column has a unique name, and each column can be associated with a different entry in `$this->lookup_data`. Just because [http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/infrastructure-faq.html #faq09](http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/infrastructure-faq.html#faq09) shows only one insertion into `$this->lookup_data` does not mean that you can only have one - it's an array of arrays, so you can have as many as you like.
