All the 'include' files are in a separate directory called INCLUDES which can only be accessed if it is specified in the 'include_path' directive, as specified in step 3 of the installation instructions at <http://www.radicore.org/installation.php>

If you have installed the framework on a shared host it would be best to put the INCLUDES directory outside the web root so that its contents cannot be accessed through the browser.
