When you perform the step shown in

[http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/radicore-tutorial.html# build.directory](http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/radicore-tutorial.html#build.directory) it says that a task of type 'menu' will be created with the same name as the subsystem id. This menu will also be added to the main system menu (called "main_menu") which is visible when you select the "home" hyperlink.

Every time you create a LIST1 pattern it will automatically be added to the subsystem menu. Just press "home" then "subsystem" and you should see it.
