## Dear Tony,

I have calendar data that must be loaded into a scheduler for display. I must get the calendar data from the current day and one year into the future.

The following query works with MySql 5.6:

select \* from calendar where dt between curdate() and curdate() + interval 365 day;

When I run the same query through Radicore 2.04.1, I get the following error:

If I remove the + from the query, I can move forward (with a correctly reported ill-formed sql query error).

It seems that there is a bug in the regex portion of the code. Or I have missed something silly.
