modified the FilePicker pattern to include the \$picker\_include\_dir option. See \_cm\_initialiseFilePicker() for details.

fixed a bug in the FilePicker pattern which returned the file name as an absolute path instead of a relative path.

updated 'dml.mysql.class.inc' to deal with alias names for expressions when appearing in the HAVING clause for a 'SELECT count(\*) ...' query

updated 'std.datevalidation.class.inc' to include more date patterns in the getInternalDate() and getInternalDateTime() methods.

update 'std.validation.class.inc' so that if \$this->date\_format\_input is set in the calling program it will be passed to the date validation class as a temporary override to \$SESSION['date format input'].

updated 'include.library.inc' to include the array2string() function which is the reverse of parse\_str().

updated 'include.library.inc' to fix a bug in the truncateNumber() function.

updated 'std.table.class.inc' so that in the getExtraData() method the call to changeConfig() is moved from before the call to \_cm\_getExtraData() to after.

updated 'std.table.class.inc' so that in the getParentData() method the default for the \$first\_row\_only argument is TRUE instead of FALSE.
