That behaviour occurs when the 'Keep Data on Exit' flag on the MNU_TASK record (see [http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/menuguide/mnu_task\(upd1\).html](http://www.tonymarston.net/php-mysql/menuguide/mnu_task(upd1).html)) is set to 'Yes'. This means that even when you leave the task its data persists so that when you return to it it carries on from where it left off. This means that it does not repeat its initialisation process, which also means that it ignores the 'initial-passthru' value. If you want the task to restart from the beginning each time then set 'Keep Data on Exit' to 'No'
