The error is caused by the fact that the value 'pro\_product\_codes(search)' is not enclosed with single quotes in the generated query. The only time this can happen is if your code contains the following somewhere:

\$this->allow\_db\_function[] = 'initial\_passthru';

This causes the DML object to treat the value as if it were a function call, as in 'function(args)', instead of a literal value. REmove this offending line and your problem will disappear.

The only time you should EVER populate \$this->allow\_db\_function is when you KNOW that the value you are supplying is a function call and not a literal.
