(1) On all the tables in the MNU\_USER database the user\_id column is expected to be VARCHAR(16), so if you wish to populate it with something which looks like a number it will be treated as a string and not a number. This means that in any SQL query the value for user\_id must be enclosed in single quotes.

(2) You do NOT have to create those fields with the exact names. I deliberately chose to implement the AUTO\_INSERT and AUTO\_UPDATE features by using settings in the dictionary and not by the field names.
