RADICORE v1.17.0 issues sql error on Postgres v8.1.3. while trying to restrict access to a field by role (task: mnu\_role\_taskfield(multi)b):

Fatal Error: pg\_query() [function.pg-query]: Query failed: ERROR: 42803: column "mnu\_role.global\_access" must appear in the GROUP BY clause or be used in an aggregate function LOCATION: check\_ungrouped\_columns\_walker, parse\_agg.c:330 (# 256).

SQL query: SELECT count(\*) FROM mnu\_role LEFT JOIN mnu\_task ON (mnu\_task.task\_id=mnu\_role.start\_task\_id) WHERE mnu\_role.role\_id='LIMITED' HAVING global\_access='N'
