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When I use a popup for a field in the outer table of a MULTI4, the outer table's popcall() function does not get called but the inner tables popupcall() function gets called instead.

I made a small change to childForm() to get me by. I added \$found\_x = true; to the conditional where \_x\$ is being stripped off. Then added this code after the 'popup|filepicker' has been determined:

if (($pattern_id == 'MULTI4') AND ($found_x)) {
  reset($object_array);
  $objectname = key($object_array);
  $dbobject = $object_array[$objectname];
}
```

I'm sure you will have a better way, but I thought I should let you know about the issue.
