I tested and found that the contents, just before db connect, of dbprefix is 'test\_' (not empty), USER\_ERROR = 256. I install properly all of four PHP scripts. Three of them I put in includes which is under /var in /var/radicor\_lib/ver\_133/... and forth in www/RealTimeERP/dict below.
